# Job profile for Head Sacristan

**Location:** Knock

**Reporting to:** Shrine Manager

**Contract Type:** Permanent

**Hours:** 35 hours per week rostered over a 7-day week. Must be able to work

weekends, Bank Holidays, Vigils and for major seasonal events including

Easter and Christmas.

**Job Purpose:** To lead, manage and develop the Sacristy team at Knock Shrine.

## Principle duties and responsibilities

#### **Management and Supervision**

- 1. Optimise the utilisation of the Sacristy team through efficient planning and allocation of resources using the available Time Management and Booking System software.
- 2. Training, supervision, performance management and ongoing formation of the Sacristy team members.
- 3. To co-ordinate and guide the work of the Sacristy team (e.g. cleaning of altar vessels and candles, cleaning of linen)
- 4. Ordering and tracking of supplies (e.g. Altar Breads) and services (e.g. laundry) and careful supervision of supplies.
- 5. To maintain a high level of cleanliness and organisation in the Sacristies, Outdoor Candelabra and associated storage areas.
- 6. To ensure good order and cataloguing of vestments, Altar vessels and Altar Frontals.

#### **Preparation of Ceremonies**

- 1. Preparation of the continuous schedule of masses, and other liturgical events.
- 2. The setting out of vestments required for services (and as anticipated for the ceremonies of the following day).
- 3. The dressing of the altars and preparation of the Sanctuary for the celebration of ceremonies.
- 4. The preparation of the vessels for the altar and credence tables and provision of liturgical books for use on the altar, ambo and lectern.
- 5. Re-ordering for the ceremonies in the Sanctuary and Chapels, as required.
- 6. Ensuring all the necessary preparations are made for ceremonies to begin on time, and every measure is taken to mitigate the effects of unforeseen delays.
- 7. Restoring furniture and equipment to their normal place and condition after use.

## Other regular duties

- 1. Ensuring the cleanliness of the Sacristy areas, connecting corridors and the Outdoor Candelabra.
- 2. To care for designated Churches, Chapels and Altars throughout the Shrine.
- 3. The tending of candles, votive candles and sanctuary lamps and their renewal
- 4. The maintenance of good security and to ensure the environment complies with Health and Safety Regulations.
- 5. Ensure that all altar linens, vestments and frontals are kept clean, stored correctly and in good repair.
- 6. To coordinate the usage, maintenance of, and removal of seasonal items and decorations (e.g. palms, flowers, wreathes etc)
- 7. Ensure that all liturgical items are kept in good order and repair with regular cleaning and maintenance.
- 8. The storage and availability of hosts, wines, oils, booklets, candles and vessels.
- 9. Any other duties commensurate with the role of Sacristan.

## **Competencies required**

- 1. Ability to manage and develop a team of Sacristans effectively.
- 2. Must be flexible and willing to work weekends, including Church holidays. Must respond to the workload and needs of the liturgical life of Knock Shrine.
- 3. In-depth familiarity with the ritual and liturgy of the Catholic Church
- 4. An ability to collaborate with clergy, altar servers and all participants in liturgies, including visiting dignitaries
- 6. Ability to project a friendly and helpful attitude.
- 7. Be self-motivated, able to work unsupervised with an eye for detail and act on initiative when required.
- 8. To demonstrate a respectful presence in the Church and to work with discretion in a pastoral environment.
- 9. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with an empathetic approach when dealing with people in sensitive situations.
- 10. Excellent organizational skills with an ability to prioritise and meet deadlines.
- 11. Ability to delegate effectively, empowering the Sacristan team to grow, learn and perform at their highest level.
- 12. Be self-sufficient regarding office software packages including Microsoft Office.
- 13. Knowledge of current best practice in safeguarding children and vulnerable adults.
- 14. Ability to deal calmly and robustly with situations as they arise in a pressured environment

- 15. An empathy for the social and moral teachings of the Catholic Church.
- 16. A commitment to achieving Knock Shrine'2 overall mission.
